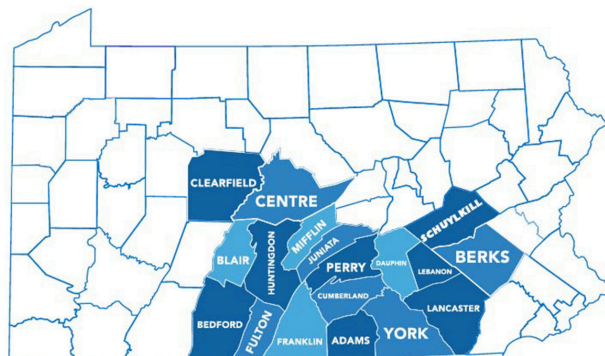
MidPenn Legal Services provides free civil legal aid to low-income families in crisis.

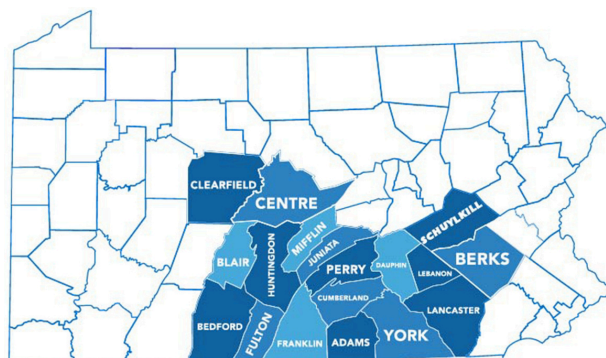
