

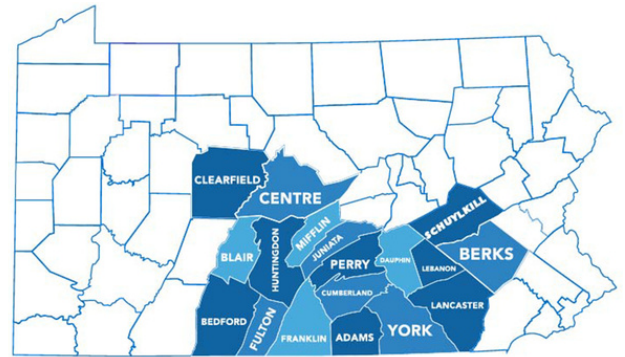
Our Mission

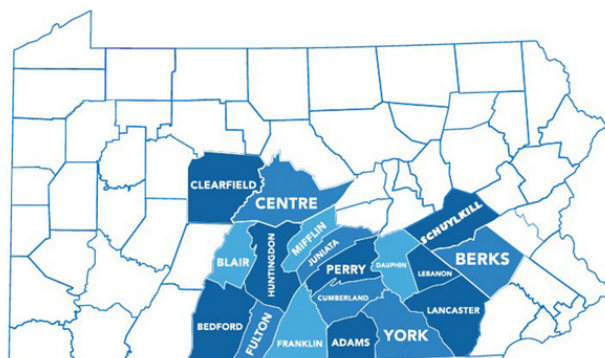
